Presentation

This property newly exploited by the Fontana family is one of their best terroir. The vineyard grow in clay-limestone soils at the top of slopes culminating at 120 metres. The parcels are south - southwest facing, enabling the vines to receive an ideal amount of sun to ensure the grapes ripen perfectly. From pruning to vinification, the Estate practices traditional, « reasoned » (sustainable) growing, with only organic manure used to enrich the soil. At harvest time, the low yielding parcels are selected and their grapes used to create a structured, concentrated wine.

Tasting note

This wine reflects an intense and deep color. The nose reveals a complex bouquet of candied red fruit and black fruit. The ample, sweet and fleshy palate unveils a tannic structure. Château Ballue Mondon is a generous wine with a beautiful length. This wine is perfect for your dishes with duck, mushroom omelettes or fresh cheese.
