Presentation

In the late 1990s Château Brown was curiously famous for the quality of its apples, grown on the "Pommeraie de Brown" plot of the estate. On this superb stretch of land with its gravel soil, covering nearly 1.74 hectares and overlooking the whole vineyard, some magnificent apple trees had been planted. These trees were felled in 1998 by Bernard Barthe (the owner from 1994 to 2004) and were replaced by some splendid vines.
