Presentation

After several years of family assistance on his father's farm, Henri Négrier bought his first parcel of vines in 1978. Wine is sold by the cooperative cellar of Saint-Seurin-de-Cadourne. In 1990, he left the cooperative cellar and transforms its old stables in winery. Expanded steadily since 1990, the area now has 24 hectares of vines in AOC Haut-Médoc and 60 acres in Saint-Estèphe appellation. The vineyard is well situated on the gravel hills lining the Gironde, surrounded by the finest wines of the Haut-Médoc.

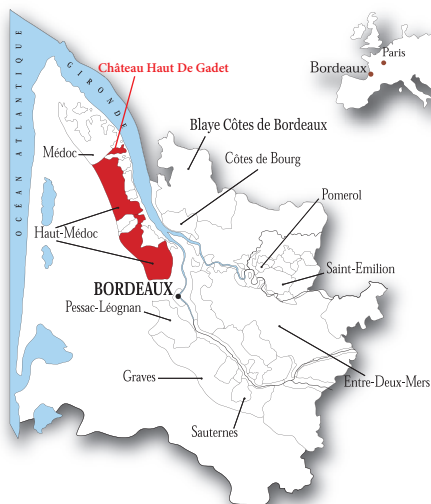

Tasting note

This wine with an intense red deep color releases a nose with raspberries and blueberries' notes. In the mouth, a nice roundness combined with perfect balance and aromas of red and black fruits testify to the richness of this exceptional wine. He will do great emphasis on grilled meats or braised chicken. Serve preferably at 18 ° C.
