**Vintage :** 2014

**Varietals:** 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot & 5% Cabernet Franc

**Vineyard area:** 30 ha.

**Average age of vines:** 35 years

**Estate Presentation:** Chateau Richebon stems from the 5<sup>th</sup> classified growth Chateau Croizet-Bages, as it was founded by the Croizet brothers in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. Since 1942 the Quié family has owned the Chateau. Jean Philippe and his sister Anne-Francoise are carefully respecting traditional techniques of the family by carrying out a twenty one day soft maceration period so as to extract the most elegant fruity notes from the grapes which is so particular to the Pauillac appellation.

**Tasting Notes :** Boasting a lovely ruby-red color with purple tints, this wine releases scents of red berries, cassis and blueberry, along with a hint of fresh vanilla. On the palate the attack is fleshy and intense, with velvety tannins. Flavors of ripe cherry emerge, mingling with notes of mild spices and paprika. Light wood notes come out, although respecting the fruity character of the wine. The finish is long and flavorful.
