## Presentation

Founded in 1878, this family property has been managed by Paul and Lorette Valade for over thirty years. Originally located in the Castillon-Côtes de Bordeaux appellation, the vineyards expanded into St Emilion in 2007.

On this property, every effort is made to ensure that the wines produced are of impeccable quality. Traditional expertise, handed down from generation to generation, combined with long hours of hard work in the vineyards and a meticulous approach to each task, enables the Château to produce outstanding wines from the St-Emilion Grand Cru and Castillon-Côtes de Bordeaux.

Located in the St Christophe des Bardes commune, Château Valade offers this cuvée from the « Renaissance » of the estate. We discover a rich and complex wine thanks to a barrel aging of 12 months.

## Tasting note

A wine which combines powerful fruit with judicious ageing. On the nose, ripe fruit and spices mingle with toasted notes. Concentrated, full, meaty and well-structured on the palate. This rich, complex wine possesses very good ageing potential.
