## Vineyard

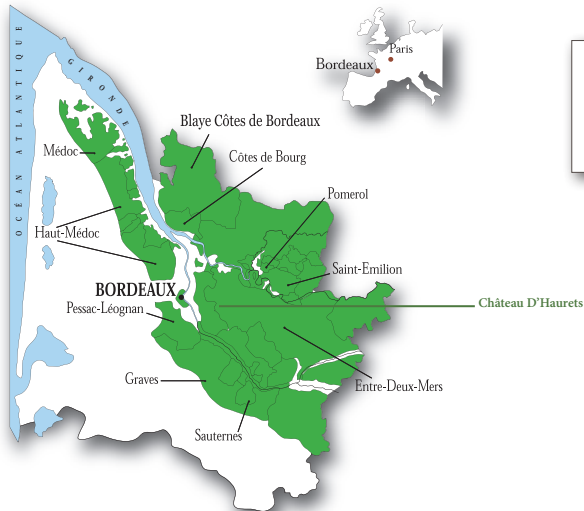
Vineyard area : 14.8 ha.
