#### Vineyard

Vineyard area: 6 ha.  
Location: Saint-Emilion  
Soil: Gravel and iron-sands  
Average age of the vines: 30 years

#### Grape Varieties :

80% Merlot  
20% Cabernet Franc

Lying at the gateway to the mediaeval town among the very best terroirs in Saint-Émilion, the vineyard of Clos des Jacobins dates back to the 17<sup>th</sup> century.

French writer René Barjavel said of it: "Wines, like people resemble the name they bear. (...) the wine of Les Jacobins, the third to carry the name, is intense like a ceremony. It surprises as soon as it touches the palate, unveiling its countless flavours that accompany and support each other in a harmonious procession. It occupies the tongue like a crowd in the sun, happy and radiant, singing the glories of a cloudless sky."

In honour of its prestigious past as a château owner, Cordier has brought the iconic "La Réserve des Jacobins" cuvée created in 1960 back to life. The bottle is an authentic reproduction of a famous bottle design used in the 20<sup>th</sup> century for this exceptional wine.

*The 2010 is enticing, rich and opulent, with a supple elegance and great volume. The garnet sparkle of the robe echoes the wonderfully ripe fruit of the nose, with prominent notes of plum and cherry. On the palate the Réserve 2010 is full-bodied, silky, substantial and well-balanced. The long, fresh finish is underpinned by a delicious hint of blackberry jam.*
